Please label all supplies prior to sending them to school

Please send on Tuesday, September 8th

- ☐ **Plastic Pencil Box** (8" x 5") - LABELED – a hard, plastic box that shuts tight to keep your child's supplies in. Please avoid zippers or textured tops as your child's name tag will be attached to the top.
- ☐ **3 Pocket Folders** – LABELED – Durable hard plastic (not paper) with bottom pockets. Please label with your child's name on the top of the front cover. Two will be used in class and the other will be used daily for your child's take-home folder.
- ☐ **Extra set of clothes in a plastic bag** (Make sure to include underwear and socks - 2-gallon size Ziploc works well) – LABELED- in case of bathroom accidents, milk spills, etc. Each child must have his/her own clothing available. The nurse does not have extra clothes. Please label each piece of clothing as well as the plastic bag!!
- ☐ **Backpack** – LABELED - A large backpack - preferably one without wheels. Please put your child's name on/in it and send it to school daily.

Please send on Wednesday, September 9th:

- ☐ **2 Large Boxes of Tissues** - for our classroom supply of tissues.
- ☐ **1 Adult sized shoe box** - LABELED on the inside - This is for a special project we will do in class.

Please only send the items listed. If anything else is needed during the school year, a note will be sent home. Thank you!

Welcome to Second Grade!

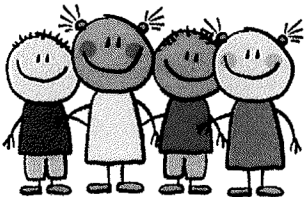
Dear Second Grader,

**Please use a black Sharpie and label all materials with your child's name. Students can place all of their extra items in a Freezer Bag Size Ziploc and keep it in their cubby.



- 1 - Zippered binder (the soft nylon seem to last the longest)
- 1 - Folder with 3 hole punched (Hold Folder, kept in desk)
- 1 - Folder (Plastic 3-hole punch for HW & Take Home)
- 1 - Three (3) Subject Notebook (ELA) - The plastic cover type is

suggested, as they hold up the longest. They are used daily and kept all year long. Experience has shown that the paper type covered notebooks do not last more than a couple of months and will need to be replaced!

- 2 - Single subject notebooks -

Please write your child's name and the Subject on the front cover with black Sharpie.

- Science - any color
- Math- any color
- Several Pencils (blue or black pens are optional)
**Mechanical pencils are not allowed in 5th Grade!!
- 1 - pair of child size scissors
- 4 - Large Glue Sticks. Used on a daily basis and must be replenished.
(No liquid glue, please)
- 2- Hi-Lighters (Any Color)
- 1 - Colored pencils pack (8 count is plenty)
- 2 boxes of tissues
