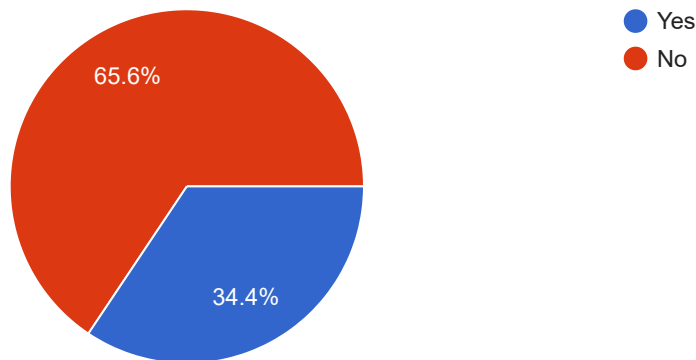


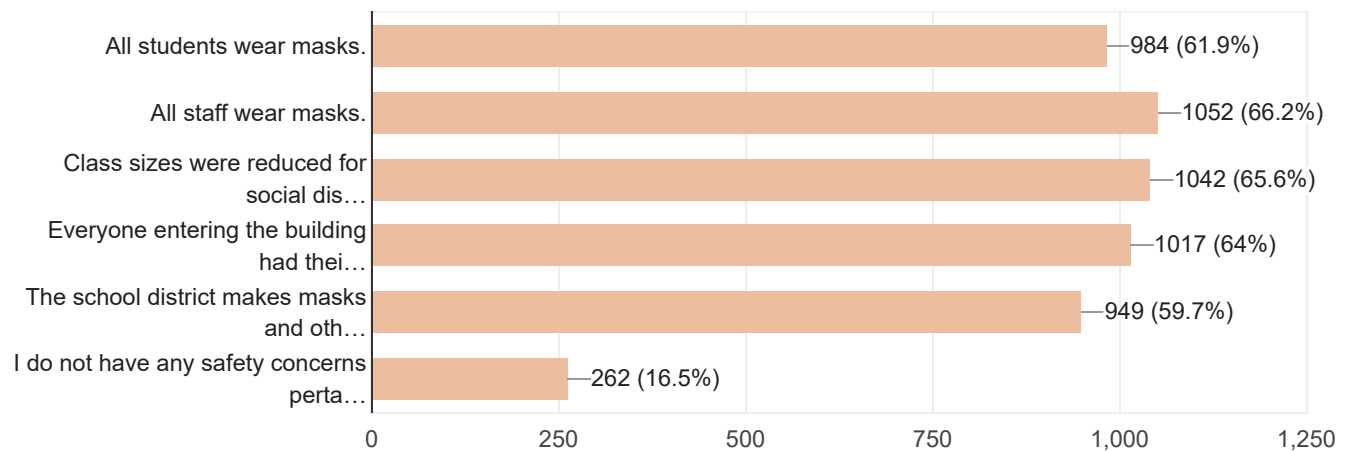
Does your child or an immediate family member have an underlying health condition that impacts your thinking about sending your child back to school?

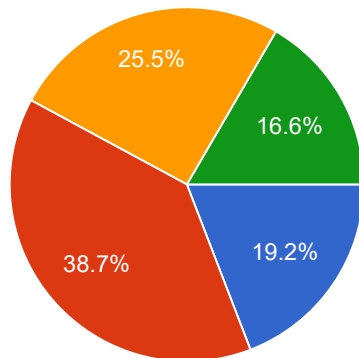
My child would be safe at school if: (check all that apply)

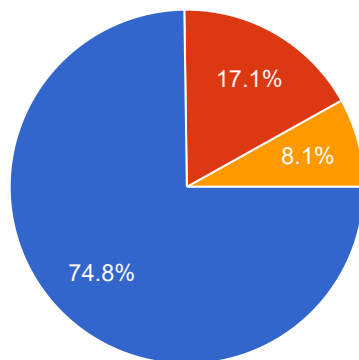

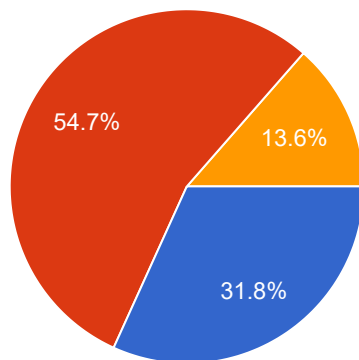

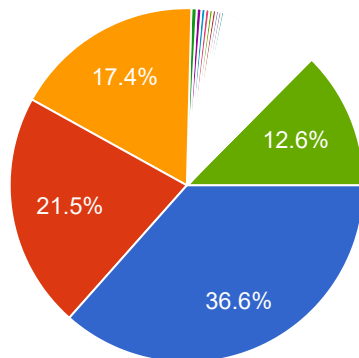

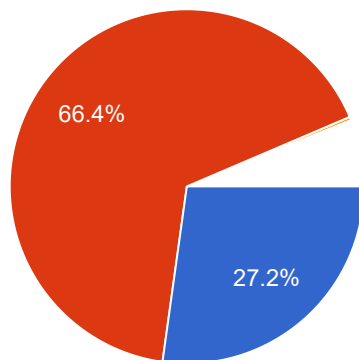
