Supply List

- 1 pack of colored pencils (package of 8-12 basic colors is fine)

- Spiral bound notebook

- Crew neck t-shirt and sweatshirt
(no inappropriate logos)
- Elastic waist shorts (appropriate length)
- Socks, sneakers (that tie or velcro securely)
- Deodorant (stick) to keep in PE Locker

- pocket folder
