Suggested Supplies

We believe these supplies are essential for a successful 6th grade year

- Either **one** three-inch binder with three rings OR **two** one and a half inch binders with three rings. This is a personal preference.
- 2 packs of loose-leaf paper (to be replaced throughout the year)
- 4 **plastic** folders with pockets and three holes to go into binder. As we use these the whole year we have found the plastic ones to be more durable. We also ask that they have a specific color for each core subject. Math (Blue), Social Studies (Black), ELA (Yellow), and Science (Green).
- #2 pencils (to be replaced throughout the year)
- A pack of dry erase markers (math)
- ****OPTIONAL**** - students frequently use calculators in math and science. We have a class set of calculators, but students who wish to purchase their own are encouraged to do so. We recommend a Texas Instruments TI-30X IIS 2.
- Black or blue pens (to be replaced throughout the year)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 pack of 8-10 colored pencils
- All students will be using the same assignment notebook, which can be paid for during the August Open House or during homeroom the first week of school.
- A cheap set of earbuds to be used with the computer-this is a **MUST** since we cannot share headphones.



We strongly encourage the use of a durable pencil pouch with three holes to keep in binder, rather than the traditional tool boxes used in elementary.

We will show you how to organize your binder and folders during the first week of school. We cannot stress enough how important it is to keep your materials organized. Being and staying organized will be a big help to you in Middle School.
