**IN PREPARING THE COURSE SELECTION SHEET,
PLEASE REMEMBER:**

1. **Enroll** in at least 6 credits including physical education at all times, (Board of Education policy).
 2. **Obtain** advice from parents, classroom teachers, and guidance counselors concerning course selections. Before selecting courses, give careful thought to goals, interests and aptitudes. Take the most challenging courses possible.
 3. **Check** graduation requirements. Guidance counselors are available to help you understand the requirements and will double check these forms.
 - These courses are your first choice requests. Should a scheduling conflict arise, a counselor will contact you for adjustments.
 - Course drops after the school year begins are made **only** if it can be determined that a student is inappropriately placed according to ability. Permission to change courses must be given by the department head, the teacher, the counselor, the parent and the principal.
 4. **Look over** the complete High School Program Planning Guide online so that you are familiar with the graduation requirements, sequence requirements and course descriptions. - ▶ **Your program form MUST be signed by you and your parent or guardian before it is handed in to your guidance counselor.**

 - ▶ **Any necessary changes after the school year begins will be addressed on an individual basis after the ninth week and before the 20th week of the course.**
