Proposed Capital Improvement Project

On Tuesday, May 18, voters in the Scotia-Glenville Central School District will decide on a \$12,800,000 capital project that includes renovations and updates at all of the District school buildings, as well as parking and bus loop improvements. Voting will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. in the B-wing gymnasium at the high school.

If approved, the proposed project would address a variety of needs and enhancements that will vastly improve the educational experience of our students, safety, and energy efficiency.

Project Highlights

The scope of work under consideration includes code compliance and ADA upgrades, roof replacements at the Glendaal and Glen-Worden Elementary Schools, a new PA system throughout the District, extensive upgrades to existing heating and cooling systems in most buildings, and asbestos abatement. Site work includes reconstruction of the parking lot and bus loops at the Middle School and Glendaal Elementary and exterior ramp / stair improvements at Sacandaga and Glen-Worden Elementary Schools.

Work will take place at the Senior High School, Middle School, Glendaal Elementary, Glen-Worden Elementary, Lincoln Elementary, and Sacandaga Elementary schools.

Project Design

New York State requires all school districts to thoroughly examine their facilities with the help of architects and engineers and complete a building condition survey every five years. The survey completed during the 2015-16 school year helped identify areas that needed attention. Additional input was provided by the Board of Education, a building advisory committee, staff survey and student groups.

Project Cost

State building aid ratio is 76.5 percent. That means that 76.5 percent of the cost of the projects will be returned to Scotia-Glenville through higher state building aid, which is typically not altered in state budgets. It is estimated that 99 percent of the project will be eligible for building aid. Since it is reconstruction, the aid would be repaid over a 15 year period.

The proposed capital project is intended to have NO INCREASE TO THE TAX LEVY.

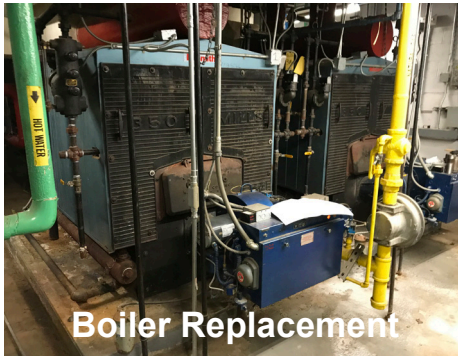
