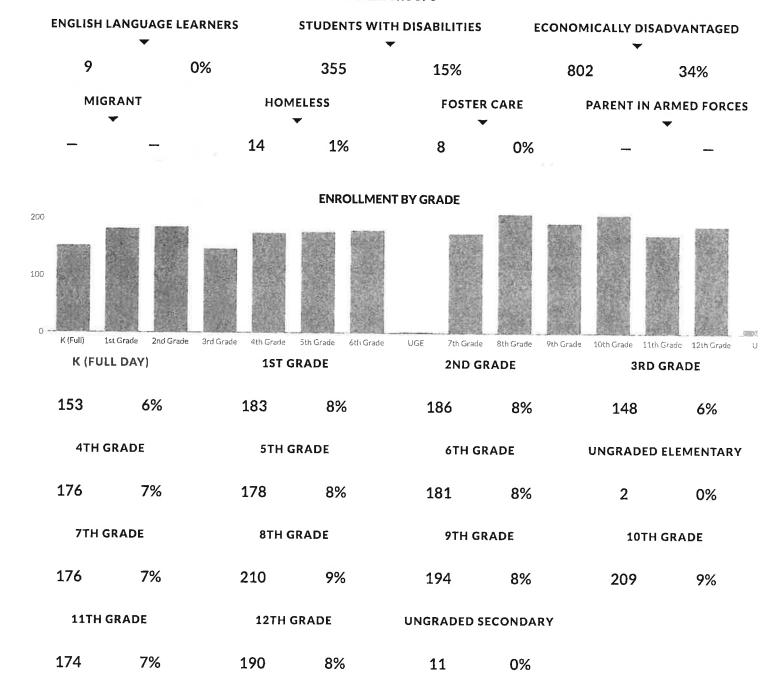




#### **ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY**

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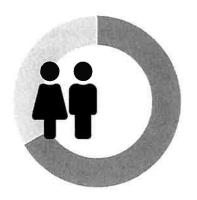

#### **ELL ENROLLMENT BY GENDER**





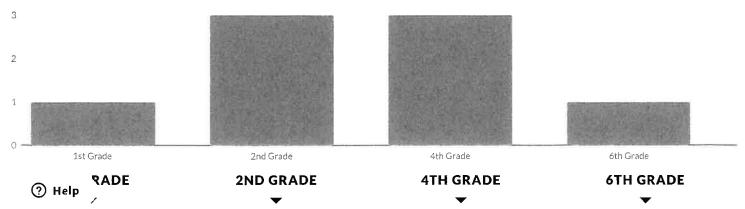
#### **ELL ENROLLMENT BY ETHNICITY**

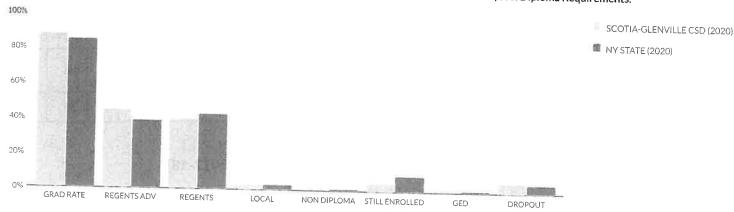
