

# **Glenville Police Benevolent Association Scholarship (\$1,000)**

## **Eligibility Requirements**

- \* A graduating student, residing within the Town of Glenville, who is attending either Burnt Hills–Ballston Lake High School, Scotia-Glenville High School, or Niskayuna High School and is enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited two- or four-year institution of higher learning.
- \* The applicant is planning a future career within Law Enforcement. This will be shown through a written essay to be submitted with the application, a Criminal Justice major is **not** required to be considered for this Scholarship.

## **Application Requirements**

- \* This application must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from a high school official (e.g. teacher, guidance counselor, class advisor, etc.).
- \* A letter of acceptance from the institution of higher learning to be attended.
- \* A typed one-page essay by the applicant explaining their desired career in Law Enforcement and why they are pursuing that career.
- \* An application will not be considered unless all requirements of the application have been completed and all documents received on or before the deadline.

**\*\*\*All applications must be submitted through the Scotia Glenville Scholarship Packet.\*\*\***

## **Selection of Scholarship Recipient**

- \* Applications will be evaluated by the Glenville PBA Board.
- \* The Board reserves the right to interview the top applicants before a final selection is made.
- \* All applicant information is confidential.

## **Award of Scholarship**

- \* The scholarship recipient will be notified by the Glenville PBA President.
- \* The \$1,000 scholarship is a non-renewable, one-time award.
- \* Award will be made directly to the student, upon successful completion of the first semester and proof of registration for the second semester at an accredited institution of higher learning.
- \* If the selected student does not successfully complete the first semester, or register for the second semester, the scholarship may be awarded to an alternate.
