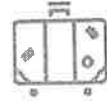

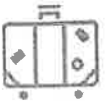

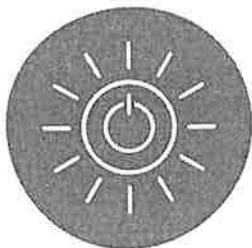
### WHAT IS CARBON OFFSETTING?

Offsetting the emissions from flight or bus travel helps to maintain a clean planet while empowering travelers to take action and make a difference.

### THE SAN ANTONIO EL SITIO WIND POWER PROJECT

Jumpstreet and WorldStrides Canada have selected the San Antonio El Sitio Wind Power Project to receive our travelers' carbon offsets. El Sitio is the first wind power project in Guatemala, contributing to an approximate reduction of 81,392 tonnes of carbon emissions per year by displacing an equivalent amount of electricity generation. The project's construction increased employment opportunities in the region and will continue to provide socio-economic benefits throughout its operation.
