World Language Honor Society

Proposal by David Viall with contributions from the Spanish, French and German departments.



Objective Statement:

Create a nationally recognized World Language Honor Society chapter here at Scotia-Glenville high school to reward students having completed multiple years of foreign language. It will comprise 3 separate organizations into a local chapter with meetings and induction being conducted together.

Nationally recognized sub-honor societies:

Spanish Honor Society - Sociedad Hispánica

French Honor Society - Société Honoraire de Français

German Honor Society - Deutsche Ehrenverbindung

Requirements:

- Have attained a 90 or higher average for each year of language up to level 3 in order to be granted permission for induction.
 - Have attained a 90 or higher average in at least one year of university level language to be able to wear an honor cord at graduation.
 - Students must conduct themselves in an appropriate manner in their classes, particularly in their respective language class.
 - Must maintain academic integrity (ex. No prior inappropriate use of translation services)
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Important Information:

- Students will be required to pay for their induction costs (approximately 5\$ but varies by language).
- Initial fees for the charter will be paid for by the respective language club.
- Applications will be submitted to respective language teachers.
- A bank account will be set up for the honor society as a whole to pay expenses and do fundraisers if needed.
