The purpose of the Glenville Hill Volunteer Fire Company Scholarship is an ongoing fund established for an annual scholarship of \$250.00. The intent of the scholarship is for a high school graduating senior to be awarded each June at the formal Awards assembly. The Glenville Hill Volunteer Fire Company will provide the \$250.00 on an annual basis to a student who has met the criteria for the award.

The scholarship will be awarded on an annual basis who is a resident in the Town of Glenville and who has demonstrated positive qualities as a volunteer in the community and school. In addition, integrity, leadership qualities, concern for others, and the ability to work harmoniously with individuals will be important considerations. The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial incentive to a qualified student who plans on attending a post-graduate school. In the absence of a qualified Town of Glenville resident, the scholarship will not be given out.

Selection Committee:

The Selection Committee will consist of three members of the Glenville Hill Volunteer Fire Company.

Application and Selection Procedures:

Each applicant is required to submit a letter describing why he/she meets the criteria of the award and three (3) letters of recommendation. Please include all volunteer activities that he/she has been involved in during high school.
