RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Scotia-Glenville Central School District, Schenectady, Montgomery and Saratoga Counties, New York, is hereby authorized to purchase two (2) school buses and one Suburban for the transportation of students at a maximum estimated cost of \$415,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of said School District and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law; and, in anticipation of such tax, obligations of said School District shall be issued.

The District will utilize the Voter Register of The Schenectady County Board of Elections as certified to the District by the County Board of Elections.

Applications for absentee ballots for election of Board Members and voting upon all propositions may be applied for at the office of the Clerk of the District. A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots shall have been issued will be available in the said office of the Clerk on each of the five days prior to the day of the election except Saturdays and Sundays.
