BUDGET DISCUSSION: 2023-2024 BUDGET WORK SESSION – SUSAN SWARTZ, SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

Superintendent Swartz opened the budget discussion with details on what a contingency budget would look like if the District was put in that position. She explained that the District would need to cut \$1,285,657 if a contingency budget was put into place. She then brought forward her second draft recommendations which included reductions in expenses of \$238,843.00. These reductions, along with an increase in revenue projections would get the District to a 2.99% tax levy with a projected tax rate of 2.09%. The Board will consider the information presented and will discuss further at next Monday's meeting. (This document is contained as Appendix A to these minutes).
