Applicants must worship in Albany or southern Rensselaer County, be active in their school and faith community, understand and plan to apply the teachings of Dr. King, show evidence of academic potential and financial need, and be accepted at an accredited college/university.

The Kimberly Coffey Foundation Memorial Nursing Scholarship

Application-The Kimberly Coffey Foundation Memorial Nursing Scholarship is awarded annually in honor of Kimberly's beautiful spirit to deserving high school seniors across New York who are pursuing a career in Nursing. Kimberly's dream was to be a pediatric nurse, and through this scholarship, it is our hope to keep her memory alive. To be considered for the Kimberly Coffey Foundation scholarship, candidates must have a minimum GPA of 3.2, provide an acceptance letter from an accredited BSN nursing program, provide documentation of receiving the meningococcal vaccination and booster, and provide documentation of starting or completing a meningococcal serogroup B vaccination series.

John Lepping Memorial Scholarship-\$5,000- The John Lepping Memorial Scholarship has been designed by the Lep Foundation for Youth Education, a public charity that provides financial assistance to students residing in NY, NJ or PA seeking to further their education by attending college. This scholarship will help to deter the costs of college for disabled individuals who may not have the resources due to overwhelming medical costs. Eligibility including, but not limited to physical conditions (spinal cord injury, loss of limb, birth defects, etc.) and psychological conditions (autism, post- traumatic stress etc.). Scholarship recipients must be able to provide proof of disability with letter of confirmation by a physician. The purpose of the program is to encourage and support young runners in their efforts to make running a lifelong part of a healthy lifestyle. The awards will be limited to track or cross-country runners currently attending a Section II high school who plan to attend on a full-time basis a college, university, or community college and continue to participate in track or cross-country.
