## • Planning and Preparation

Ms. Morris is organized and prepared for daily lessons and is receptive to direction from the general and special education teacher in the classroom. She was an employee in last summer's Extended School Year (ESY) program and occasionally assumed a lead teaching role. In each instance, the classroom operated in a smooth manner with students engaged in learning. Ms. Morris collects and organizes materials, contacts necessary stakeholders, follows up with phone calls, and performs all tasks needed related to the daily routine. She also has a thorough grasp of each student's schedule and what is needed to support the transitions.

### Classroom Environment-

Ms. Morris is a great asset to the classroom environment and has developed positive relationships with students. She seeks to connect with each student on a personal level and can effectively intervene with more challenging student behaviors. Ms. Morris supports the special education teacher by implementing academic and behavioral routines with consistency.

### • Instruction

She provides scaffolded support and helps facilitate student independence by gradually fading support, when appropriate.
