• Planning and Preparation

Ms. Myers is organized and prepared for daily lessons and works well under the direction of the special education teacher. She effectively engages students in instruction and knows when to encourage persistence and when to modify the activity based upon the student's response. She dutifully performs TA-related responsibilities like preparing and organizing academic materials, keeping running records, and documenting student behavior, to name a few. Ms. Myers has a thorough grasp of each student's schedule and academic needs.

• Classroom Environment-

Students enjoy working with Ms. Myers as she has a natural way of connecting with them. She gets to know each student on a personal level and exhibits patience, compassion and boundaries with students who exhibit challenging behaviors.
