## • Planning and Preparation –

Ms. Stone is appropriately prepared for lessons. She collaborates with general education teachers and reviews students' IEPs to provide Specially Designed Instruction. She is organized and keeps appropriate documentation of parent phone calls, progress monitoring, running records, and more.

#### Classroom Environment-

Ms. Stone establishes appropriate relationships with students by incorporating their strengths and interests into daily conversations, routines, and lessons. The teacher-student rapport is highly evident and allows for effective classroom management and ultimately student learning. Students enjoy working with Ms. Stone.

#### Instruction –

In her current role, Ms. Stone pushes into multiple grade levels for ELA and/or Math. As a result, she is knowledgeable about the learning standards and local curriculum.
