Attached please find the Food Service list for 2023-24. Meal prices have been adjusted by ten cents, based on the contract with Chartwells and the recommendation of Jim Bigley of HMB Consultants. Historically, over the last five years, we have typically adjusted lunch prices by ten cents, except for this past year where we increased by slightly more due to the bid specifications and bid award to Chartwells. Breakfast prices are not being increased as we are trying to encourage more participation in the breakfast program.

There were some price changes to the ala carte items, these changes are highlighted in yellow and are based on negotiations between the District and Chartwells, with input from HMB Consultants.

Attached you will also find a comparison of meal prices from surrounding school districts. This comparison reflects pricing from the 2022-2023 school year as most districts have not yet approved the current year's prices.
