In December 2022, we submitted the ESSA Financial Transparency (Every Student Succeeds Act) report for fiscal year ending 6/30/22 as per Education Law Section 3614. The report was approved in late August by SED. Upon acceptance of the report by the Board of Education, we will post the information on the District website as per the Transparency and ESSA reporting requirements.

The objective of the report is to display building level expenditures. The report displays the General Fund expenditures along with Federal Grants and the School Lunch Fund. Transportation, Debt Service, Private and Charter School Tuition and Summer Special Education costs are not part of the allocation for building level expenditures.

The following reports were submitted in compliance with NYS and Federal Education requirements and have been approved:

- New York State School Funding Transparency Form 2022-2023 budget submitted and approved by Division of Budget and SED; and
- ESSA Financial Transparency report 2021-2022 expenditures submitted and approved by SED.

The spending per student per school continues to be the highest at Lincoln at \$23,299, with a 5.6% increase from 2020/21. The Middle School continues to reflect the lowest per student spending at \$19,944, with a 5.27% increase from 2020/21. The total spending continues to be the highest at the High School at \$11,608,764, reflecting a 6.28% increase from 2020/21. The lowest total spending continues to be at Glendaal at \$2,888,628, an increase of 2.04% from prior year.

Enrollment has decreased from the prior year by 24 students or 1.01% with Glendaal showing the greatest decline of 28 students and Glen Worden the greatest increase at 29 students.

District headcount increased by 12.11 with Teachers increasing by 7.87 fte, Teaching Assistants decreasing by .30 fte, Administration increasing by 1 fte and Non-Instructional increasing by 3.54 fte.

I have attached a series of charts which display in detail the key categorical changes summarized above. I have also attached the ESSA Financial Transparency Report that will be posted on the District's website upon Board approval.
