Re: Tax Collection Report  
Historical Data on Percentage of Taxes Collected During Regular Collection Period

We have received an updated report of tax collections from the collector for the Town of Glenville. A taxpayer paid taxes in September and received a receipt from the Town but the check was lost. When the issue was brought to their attention, they submitted reports reflecting the additional payment of \$3,434.73. The tax collection reports for Montgomery County and Saratoga County remain unchanged. The district treasurer reconciled deposits to the amounts reported.

Set forth below is historical data on tax collections by the school district during the September-October collection period (exclusive of STAR payments).
