What is FAFSA and how does it work! Before each year of college, apply for federal grants, work-study, and loans with the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form. Your college uses your FAFSA data to determine your federal eligibility. State deadline for application form is June 30th, 2024
