In December 2023, we submitted the ESSA Financial Transparency (Every Student Succeeds Act) report for fiscal year ending 6/30/23 as per Education Law Section 3614. The report was approved in late August by SED. Upon acceptance of the report by the Board of Education, we will post the information on the District website as per the Transparency and ESSA reporting requirements.

The objective of the report is to display building level expenditures. The report displays the General Fund expenditures along with Federal Grants and the School Lunch Fund. Transportation, Debt Service, Private and Charter School Tuition and Summer Special Education costs are not part of the allocation for building level expenditures.

The spending per student per school continues to be the highest at Lincoln at \$24,046, with a 3.21% increase from 2021/22. The High School spending per student has increased by 14.27% moving up to the 2nd highest spending per student. The Middle School also had a significant increase. Sacandaga has the lowest per student spending at \$22,438, with a 10.9% increase from 2021/22. The total spending continues to be the highest at the High School at \$11,720,962, reflecting a .97% increase from 2021/22. The lowest total spending continues to be at Glendaal at \$2,883,636, a decrease of .17% from the prior year.

Enrollment has decreased from the prior year by 137 students or 5.84% with the High School showing the greatest decline of 86 students and Lincoln the greatest increase at 10 students.

District headcount increased by 16.8 with Teachers increasing by 6.61 fte and Teaching Assistants increasing by 10.19 fte.

I have attached a series of charts which display in detail the key categorical changes summarized above. I have also attached the ESSA Financial Transparency Report that will be posted on the District's website upon Board approval.
