**1 full set of
clothes in a large
labeled Ziploc bag**
(Inc case of an accident.)



**1 rectangular
box of plain
tissues**

(No aloe or vicks.)



**Elmer's purple washable
disappearing glue sticks**

(You pick any amount from 1-8. No name needed.)



**1 box of
24 count crayons**

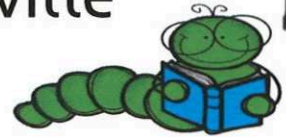
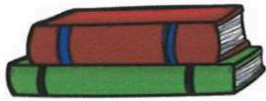

Welcome to Second Grade! Here is a list of supplies you'll need when we start school in September.

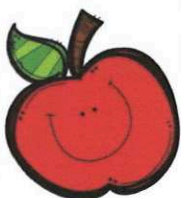
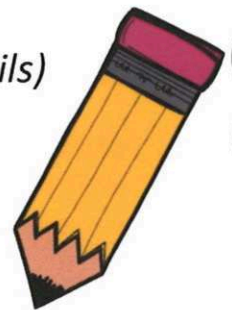
Regular pencils and glue sticks will be collected and given out as needed. All extra personal supplies will be kept in cubbies.

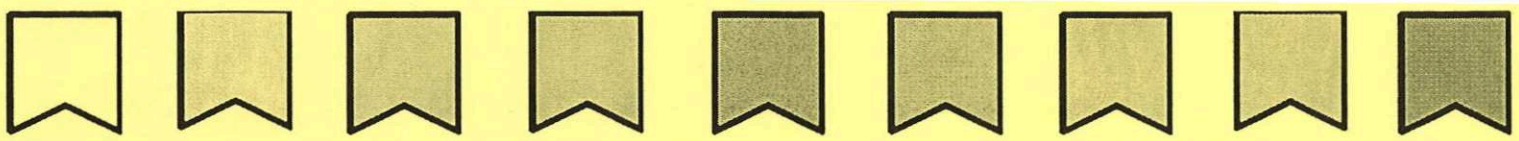
****A Lincoln School take-home folder and a set of headphones will be supplied for each child by the school.****

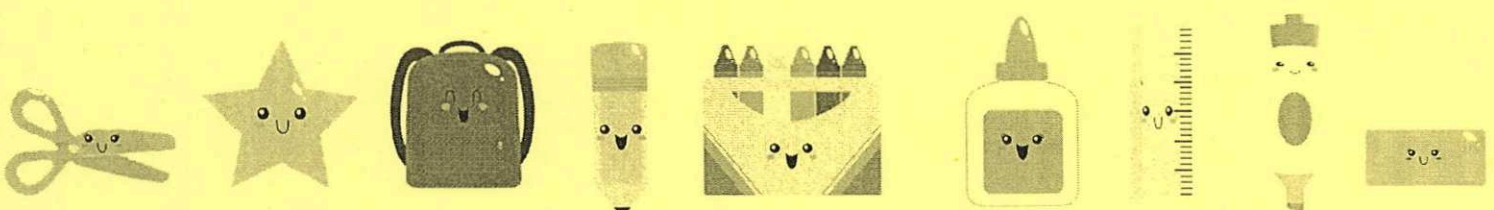
- **Pencils-** 3 dozen sharpened

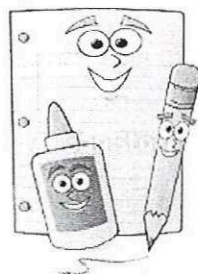

We are excited to have your child move up to fourth grade! There are several items that your child will need during the school year. We encourage you to take advantage of the "Back To School" sales this summer, when purchasing your child's supplies.

- #2 Pencils (2 dozen - no plastic coatings/designs due to damaging classroom pencil sharpeners)
- Erasers
- Glue Sticks (2 large or more)
- Colored Pencils
- Zipper Pencil Pouch to hold supplies (NO BOXES)
- Highlighter
- Composition Notebooks (quantity 4)
 - * Color coordinated for organization (see folders below)
- Plastic Folders (1 blue, 1 green, 1 yellow, 1 red, 1 black)
 - **Folders are color coded for each subject for organizational purposes -
- Scissors
- Tissues (quantity 3)
- Wipes
- 1 pack of wide ruled lined paper
